MOWING OF LOTS AND WILFUL OBSTRUCTION

The Village of Ludlow may adopt, amend, repeal and enforce ordinances or rules for any purpose authorized by law under Vermont Statutes, Title 24, Chapter 59, Sections 1971, 1972, and 1973.

ARTICLE 1. MOWING LOTS

- 1.01 Any person or persons owning a lot in the Village of Ludlow shall, before the first of each month for lawns and before August 15th for lots, cause the lot or lawn to be mowed and cleaned of all weeds, hay, brush, deleterious, unhealthy growth or other noxious matter that may be growing, lying or located thereon.

ARTICLE 2. WILFUL OBSTRUCTION

- 2.01 A person, who willfully fells trees, plows snow or places an obstruction or other nuisance in the public highway will be subject to penalty.

ARTICLE 3. ENFORCEMENT

- 3.01 These ordinances may be enforced by any law enforcement officer of the Town or Village of Ludlow or the State of Vermont. Prosecution shall be brought by the State's Attorney.

ARTICLE 4. PENALTY

- 4.01 Except as hereinafter provided, the fines for the violation of any section of this ordinance will be \$100.00 for Article 1 and \$100.00 for Article 2.

ARTICLE 5. PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE

The foregoing ordinance is hereby adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ludlow this 17th day of July 1978.

ARTICLE 5 above is amended to read:

- 5.01 No section of this Ordinance shall be construed to supersede or replace any Vermont statute.
- 5.02 This Ordinance shall be entered in the minutes of the Board of Trustees meeting, and posted in at least five (5) conspicuous places with the Village of Ludlow and published in a newspaper circulating in the Village on a day not more than fourteen (14) days following the date when the Ordinance is adopted.
- 5.03 This Ordinance shall become effective on June 2, 2008, sixty (60) days after the date of its adoption by the Village Board Trustees, unless a petition is filed with the Village Clerk by May 15, 2008, forty-four (44) days after the date of its adoption. The petition should be addressed to the Village Trustees, should be signed by at least five percent (5%) of the qualified voters of this municipality, and should ask for a special meeting to be called on the question of disapproving the ordinance.
