

VILLAGE OF LUDLOW, VERMONT

SNOW REMOVAL ORDINANCE

1. Enabling Authority
2. Penalty
3. Severability
4. Publication and Effective Date

ARTICLE 1. ENABLING AUTHORITY

Pursuant to authority contained in Sec. 40 of No. 122 of the Acts of 1892, the Trustees of the Village of Ludlow do hereby make and adopt the following regulation and by-law relating to the moving and removal of snow and ice within the Village limits:

- 1.01 No person, persons, company and/or corporation shall plow, shovel or move any snow or ice from the driveways or other private properties (except for sidewalks) of said person(s), company and/or corporation onto any street, sidewalk or other public way maintained by the Village.

ARTICLE 2. PENALTY

- 2.01 The penalty for violation of the above regulation and by-law as set forth in Sec. 43 of No. 122 of the Acts of 1892 as follows:
 - a. "Sec. 43. A fine not exceeding \$20.00 with costs."

ARTICLE 3. SEVERABILITY

- 3.01 If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance, or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or any part thereof.
- 3.02 The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional or ineffective.

ARTICLE 4. PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE

The foregoing ordinance is hereby adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of

Ludlow, Vermont, this 13th day of January, 1954.

ARTICLE 4 above is amended to read:

- 4.01 No section of this Ordinance shall be construed to supersede or replace any Vermont statute.
- 4.02 This Ordinance shall be entered in the minutes of the Board of Trustees meeting, and posted in at least five (5) conspicuous places with the Village of Ludlow and published in a newspaper circulating in the Village on a day not more than fourteen (14) days following the date when the Ordinance is adopted.
- 4.03 This Ordinance shall become effective on June 2, 2008, sixty (60) days after the date of its adoption by the Village Board Trustees, unless a petition is filed with the Village Clerk by May 15, 2008, forty-four (44) days after the date of its adoption. The petition should be addressed to the Village Trustees, should be signed by at least five percent (5%) of the qualified voters of this municipality, and should ask for a special meeting to be called on the question of disapproving the ordinance.
