Old Business

- Money continues to come in for rebuilding our Little League Park. We received \$250 from the Baptist Church and \$500 from Benson's Chevrolet.
- A meeting was held to opt out of the Cal Ripken League and form our own independent league consisting of all that towns that previously participated in the Cal Ripken League. There was no benefit to paying Cal Ripken Baseball Inc., as all participants were able to provide their own insurance.
- Ludlow Little League will play all their home games on Saturdays at Dorsey Park until the Little League Fields are ready. Hopefully we have an early spring and we will be on our fields much sooner then anticipated.
- The Town budget passed and we will be hiring an assistant beginning on July 1.

- We will only be hiring 6 counselors for our Summer Youth Camp this year. Returning counselors are Katie O’Neil who will be the Camp Director, Alyssa Collins and Tim Rumrill. For the remaining three spots we have six applicants. The board supports the decision to hire, Emily Hammond, Zoe Trimboli and Hannah Josselyn, and as substitute, Ben Veysey. The Board feels that preference should be given to qualified Ludlow Residents.
