II. Approval of November minutes. Motion to approve by Patricia Rumrill. Joe Gurdak seconded.

III. Directors Report. Howie reported to the committee; That open gym continues to see a lot of use especially from 2:30- 4:30 after school and weekends from 10-3. The fitness center currently has 10 gym memberships. Pick up basketball on Wednesdays and Fridays 6-8p.m. has 30 plus participants. Too many, especially with high schoolers playing. It was agreed that this should be an adult league pick up for 18 years plus, with plenty of open gym time for students. Indoor soccer in the BRHS gym runs on Sundays from 12-3p.m. Averaging 24 participants. Usually 3 teams of 5. Christmas week had 4 games of 7. The community center continues to be rented out for birthday parties and there are three different Boy Scout groups renting the space. Winter walkers have been using the facility to walk during the cold weather. Youth basketball is well under way for grades K-6 with many of the teams participating in games before the Holidays. Adult volleyball has between 10-12 participants on Monday nights from 6-8 p.m.

IV. Old Business

The gates are open to West Hill for sledding, however, there is not much snow.

V. New Business

Youth Hockey; Howie was going to contact Christina Graves about helping coordinate. It runs on Sundays and Wednesdays at the ice house from 4:00-5:30p.m.

Heather Tucker informed the committee that there was currently a fund raising campaign for updating the gym with ADM bleachers, paint and refurbished floor.

Howie asked the committee if Ludlow rec could host a middle school basketball tournament in mid February. All agreed it was a good idea; charging admission \$1 students/ \$3 adult.
