Approval of Minutes:

Director's Report:

- Youth basketball has ended with the boys winning the Flood Brook tournament.
- Community Center continues to be used by the adults for volleyball and basketball, along with pickleball players that are utilizing the facility on Mondays' and Thursdays' afternoons.
- Baseball registration has begun, will most likely combine the teams with Cavendish.
- Vermont Rec & Parks Association is holding a Vt. State Pickleball Championship tournament this year and Ludlow maybe participating in this event.

Old Business:

- Skatepark: On March 9th the skateboard committee and Nick met with Skatepark to finalize the plans. Starting date was scheduled for April 1st, maybe pushed out due to the amount of snow, Scott suggested we may be able to get the remaining snow removed. August 1st is the scheduled date to open the park,
- West Hill: Have not yet received the contract from LEWCO for the dredging and re-sanding project.
- Scott suggested that we contact the state regarding stocking West Hill prior to having the fishing derby.

- Easter/Egg Hunt: Easter Egg Hunt will be held on Saturday, April 1st, the American Legion has again offered to contribute the candy for this event.
- Green Up Day/Opening Day: Scheduled for May 6th, once again Ludlow's opening day will be combined with Cavendish.
- Mt. Bike Park: Received the contract, however, there is a \$150.00 discrepancy between the contract and what we had agreed upon. Starting date has not been confirmed, once started the project should be completed in 30 days.
- Dog Park: Engel & Volkers Real Estate will be contacting Ted Stryhas to donate wood and labor to make features for the dog park. Trees will be planted in the spring.

New Business:

- Fundraising: Marissa and Nick ran the concession stand during the basketball tournaments and made over \$500.00. Looking for volunteers to run the concession stand on Opening Day, May 6th. Nick to contact Kim Lambert to apply to be the candidate for the duck race proceeds.
