Approval of Minutes:

Director's Report:

- Youth basketball is coming to an end, with final tournaments to take place in the first week of March.
- Community Center continues to be used every night for youth basketball, adults also taking advantage of the facility, by participating in open gym, volleyball, basketball and pickleball, The community center is also being used by the Boy Scouts for their meetings, blood drives and the monthly community meals. The community center is hoping to start weekend hours, depending on the availability of staff.

Old Business:

- Skatepark: Received 3 bids for the skatepark project, the committee met with the bidders and recommended the bid be awarded to Skatepark. Select Board approved. Okemo Mountain will be donating \$10,000 towards the skateboard park with the proceeds from auctioning the old ski trail signs.
- West Hill: Received 3 bids for the dredging and resanding project at West Hill. LEWCO was the lowest bidder at \$23,000, Select Board awarded the bid to LEWCO.
- Dorsey Park: Nick and Marissa attended the Rotary Meeting and presented the playground project. Kim Lambert suggested that we apply to be candidates for the

duck race proceeds, the committee would be obligated to selling tickets for the event.

- Easter/Egg Hunt: Easter Egg Hunt will be held on Saturday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, the American Legion has again offered to contribute the candy for this event.
- Green Up Day/Opening Day: Scheduled for May 6<sup>th</sup>, once again Ludlow's opening day will be combined with Cavendish.

New Business:

- Fundraising: Marissa purchased items to be sold at the basketball concession stand and asked for volunteers to man the stand, also looking for volunteers to run the concession stand on Opening Day.
- Engel & Volkers Real Estate would like to support the dog park, the committee discussed the possibility of having them purchase features for the park.
- The water dispenser that was awarded to us last year, will be installed this spring at Dorsey Park.
