Motion to go into Executive Session Joe, seconded by Pam In at 5:25 pm. Out at 5:40pm


Next meeting date: August 4th at 5:00 at the Community Center.
One week earlier because of summer vacation schedules.


Meeting adjourned Pam, seconded by Joe. Meeting adjourned at 5:46 pm.
