


# Town of Ludlow Local Flood Hazard Areas


**ADOPTED: JULY 07, 2014**  
**EFFECTIVE: JULY 28, 2014**

Special Flood Hazard Areas (SFHA), including the Floodway and Floodplain, are shown on this map for planning purposes only. Please note that the Town of Ludlow Flood Hazard Area Regulations regulate the SFHAs per the most current flood insurance studies and maps published by the Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), National Flood Insurance Program, as provided by the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources pursuant to 10 V.S.A. §753, which are hereby adopted by reference and declared to be part of the above referenced regulations.

Stream Setback Areas (or Local Flood Hazard Area) include the land area within 50 feet of streams as measured perpendicular to the top of bank, located outside of the SFHA. The Stream Setback Areas depicted on this map are illustrative only as the 50 foot setbacks are mapped based on stream centerlines, not top of bank.
