The Town of Ludlow, VT is seeking BIDS/PROPOSALS from qualified contractors for:

FY 2024 TOWN SUMMER RETREATMENT

Bids must specify for each site the cost per ton laid in place. Contractor shall use emulsion and sweep. Proper/legal sign packages and traffic control must be in place at the construction site and supplied by each applicant.

Sealed bids marked "Town Paving Bid" are due in the Municipal Office no later than 10:00 AM on Wednesday, June 28, 2023. Bids will be opened immediately in the Town Hall Conference Room.

The Town of Ludlow Selectboard may award the bid at their regular meeting on Monday, July 10, 2023. Work to begin after July 1, 2023, and at a time coordinated with the Highway Foreman. Completion date will be no later than September 30, 2023.

The Town of Ludlow reserves the right to reject any part or all proposals. This solicitation in no way obligates the Town of Ludlow to award a contract. A valid Certificate of Insurance showing proof of the contractor's Liability and Worker's Compensation coverage and naming the Town of Ludlow as an additional insured is required with the bid proposal.
