FY 2022 VILLAGE SUMMER RETREATMENT

Bids must specify for each site the cost per ton laid in place. Contractor shall use emulsion and sweep. Proper/legal sign packages and traffic control must be in place at the construction site and supplied by each applicant.

Sealed bids marked "Village Paving Bid" are due in the Municipal Office no later than 10:00 AM on June 2, 2021. Bids will be opened immediately following the Town of Ludlow paving bid opening in the Town Hall Conference Room.

The Village Board of Trustees may award the bid at their regular meeting. Work to begin after June 30, 2021, and at a time coordinated with the Highway Foreman. Completion date will be no later than September 30, 2021.

The Village of Ludlow reserves the right to reject any part or all proposals. This solicitation in no way obligates the Village of Ludlow to award a contract. A valid Certificate of Insurance showing proof of the contractor's Liability and Worker's Compensation coverage and naming the Village of Ludlow as an additional insured is required with the bid proposal.
